Saturday 20 and Sunday 21 July

- ① Leatherhead to Dorking**
The lines between **Leatherhead** and **Dorking** will be closed **all weekend** due to maintenance work.
- Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will be diverted after **Leatherhead** and will terminate at **Guildford**.
 - Buses will run between **Leatherhead** and **Dorking**.

- ② Surbiton to Effingham Junction**
The lines between **Surbiton** and **Effingham Junction** will be closed **all weekend** due to maintenance work.

- Saturday**
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted after **Surbiton** and will terminate at **Hampton Court**.
 - Buses will run between **Surbiton** and **Effingham Junction**.
 - A revised service will run between **Effingham Junction** and **Guildford**.

- ③ Eastleigh to Fareham**
The lines between **Eastleigh** and **Fareham** will be closed **all day** due to maintenance work.
- The morning and early afternoon **London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth** via **Eastleigh** services will **not** divide at **Eastleigh** and will continue to **Poole only**.
 - The late afternoon and evening **London Waterloo to Portsmouth** via **Eastleigh** services will terminate at **Eastleigh**.
 - Buses will run between **Eastleigh** and **Fareham** **all day**.
 - A revised service will run between **Fareham** and **Portsmouth Harbour**.
 - Southampton Central to Portsmouth & Southsea stopping services will be **revised** and will continue to **Portsmouth Harbour**.

Sunday 21 July

- ④ Addlestone area**
The lines in the **Addlestone** area will be closed **all day** due to maintenance work.
- London Waterloo to Woking via **Staines** services will be **revised**. These services will be diverted after **Virginia Water** and will terminate at **Ascot**.
 - Buses will run between **Virginia Water** and **Woking**.

Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 July

- ⑤ Leatherhead to Dorking**
A revised service will run between **Leatherhead** and **Dorking** **all weekend**.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will be diverted after **Leatherhead** and will terminate at **Guildford**.
 - Passengers should change at **Leatherhead** for Southern services to **Dorking**.

- ⑥ Surbiton to Effingham Junction**
The lines between **Surbiton** and **Effingham Junction** will be closed **all weekend** due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted after **Surbiton** and will terminate at **Hampton Court**.
 - Buses will run between **Surbiton** and **Effingham Junction**.

- ⑦ Eastleigh to Fareham**
The lines between **Eastleigh** and **Fareham** will be closed **all day** due to maintenance work.
- The morning and early afternoon **London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth** via **Eastleigh** services will **not** divide at **Eastleigh** and will continue to **Poole only**.
 - The late afternoon and evening **London Waterloo to Portsmouth** via **Eastleigh** services will terminate at **Eastleigh**.
 - Buses will run between **Eastleigh** and **Fareham** **all day**.
 - A revised service will run between **Fareham** and **Portsmouth Harbour**.
 - Southampton Central to Portsmouth & Southsea stopping services will be **revised** and will continue to **Portsmouth Harbour**.

Sunday 28 July

- ⑧ Hounslow area**
The lines in the **Hounslow** area will be closed **all day** due to maintenance work.
- London Waterloo to Woking via **Staines** services will be **revised**. These services will be diverted between **Barnes** and **Feltham** and will call additionally at **Richmond** and **Twickenham**.
 - Buses will run between **Barnes** and **Feltham** via **Hounslow**.
 - The afternoon and evening **London Waterloo to Kingston** via **Hounslow** services will **not** run.
 - Buses will run between **Barnes** and **Twickenham** via **Hounslow** (afternoon and evening only).

Altered train services
Monday 29 July until Friday 2 August

Engineering work is taking place between **Barnes** and **Kew Bridge** from **Monday 29 July** until **Friday 2 August**.

- London Waterloo to Weybridge via **Hounslow** services will start from **Kew Bridge**.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via **Hounslow** peak hour services will start from **Kew Bridge**.
- Buses will run between **Barnes** and **Kew Bridge**.
