


Changes to train times Monday 19 to Holiday Monday 26 August

The lines between **Surbiton and** Effingham Junction will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted after Surbiton and will terminate at **Hampton Court**.
- **Buses** will run between **Surbiton and Effingham Junction.**
- · A **revised** service will run between **Effingham Junction and Guildford.**

Sunday 25 August

Effingham Junction area

The lines in the **Effingham Junction** area will be **closed all day** due to maintenance work.

- **London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom** services will be diverted after **Leatherhead** and will terminate at Dorking.
- Buses will run between Leatherhead and **Guildford via Effingham Junction.**
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will not run. Passengers should travel on other services from London Waterloo to Surbiton.
- **Buses** will run between **Surbiton and Guildford via Effingham Junction.**

Island Line

From Friday 6 September until Sunday 6 October 2024

Island Line Closed

The lines between **Ryde Pier Head and Shanklin** will be closed from Friday 6 September until **Sunday 6 October 2024** while a large programme of vital maintenance takes place.

Replacement buses will run between Ryde Pier Head and Shanklin.

From Friday 6 September until early May 2025

Ryde Pier Closed

Engineers will also continue to work to repair and preserve **Ryde Pier**. The pier will close to trains on Friday 6 September and is expected to reopen in early May 2025.

A minibus service will run between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade. Trains will run between **Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin** every 30 minutes.

Please check if you are planning to travel after 2200 (10pm) or before 0530 (5:30am) as buses may replace trains at short notice.
