Sunday 8 December

1 Queenstown Road area

Some lines in the Queenstown Road area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- Some London Waterloo to Windsor services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Kingston services will depart London Waterloo earlier.

Sunday 8 December

2 Woking area

The lines in the Woking area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Basingstoke. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth Harbour.
- The late afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Basingstoke and will call additionally at Micheldever and Shawford.
- The late afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Eastleigh.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- Buses will run between Woking, Guildford and Basingstoke. Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. These services will not call at Woking but will call additionally at Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will terminate at Weybridge.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be diverted after Addlestone and will terminate at Weybridge. These services will not call at Queenstown Road due to other work taking place.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Guildford via Woking.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Basingstoke via Woking.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Aldershot via Woking.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will run between Guildford and Alton via Aldershot calling additionally at Wanborough and Ash. These services will run hourly.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will be revised. These services will terminate at Aldershot. Passengers for Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to Guildford services.

Sunday 8 December

3 Reading to Basingstoke

The lines between Reading and Basingstoke will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- CrossCountry and Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.
- Reading to Salisbury services will start from Basingstoke.
- Buses will run between Reading and Basingstoke.

Island Line

Closure until May 2025

Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade will be closed until May 2025.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

- Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.
