Clandon area

The lines in the **Clandon** area will be closed due to emergency works. Trains will be unable to run between Guildford and Effingham Junction.

- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Effingham Junction.
- **Buses** will run between **Guildford**, **Effingham Junction**

Woking area

The lines in the Woking area will be closed Monday and Tuesday and also Friday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An **hourly** service will depart **earlier** from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between **Woking and Southampton Central** and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham. An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from **Basingstoke**.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading on Monday and Tuesday only. On Friday and Saturday they will start from Basingstoke.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- **Buses** will run between **Woking and Basingstoke**
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at **Woking.** These services will call additionally at **West Byfleet**.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and Additional services will run between Farnborough and
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from
- Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and **Guildford to Farnham** services will **not** run. Passengers should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo.
- Services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be **revised** and will start from **Basingstoke**. These services will **not** divide at **Eastleigh** but will call
- additionally at **Micheldever and Shawford all day.** A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth Harbour.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- Reading to Salisbury services will start from Basingstoke. Additional services will run between **London Waterloo** and Woking.
- **Buses** will run between **Woking and Basingstoke** (non-stop).
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at **Woking.** These services will run **hourly.**

Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and

- Farnborough. Additional services will run between Farnborough and
- Basingstoke. London Waterloo to Alton services will start from
- Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and **Ash.** These services will run **hourly.**
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale and Aldershot.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will terminate at Aldershot. Passengers for Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to Guildford

Island Line

Closure until May 2025

Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between **Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade** will be closed until May 2025.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

 Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.

Brockenhurst to Lymington Pier

The lines between **Brockenhurst and Lymington Pier** will be closed Monday and Tuesday, and also Friday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

- Brockenhurst to Lymington Pier services will not run.
- Buses will run between Brockenhurst and Lymington Pier.

The network will shut down completely much earlier than usual and passengers travelling during the afternoon and evening should make sure their journey will be possible before starting.

There will be no South Western Railway or Island Line services on these days.

Westbury area

The lines in the **Westbury** area will be **closed from Friday to** Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

South Western Railway services via Westbury will be revised. Some services will not run. Other services will terminate at **Salisbury** or will be diverted via **Yeovil Junction** to Yeovil Pen Mill.
