### Monday 30 December 2024 to Sunday 5 January 2025

#### 1 1 Woking area

The lines in the Woking area will be closed from Monday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An hourly service will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham. An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- On Saturday only, London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will terminate at Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at Woking. These services will call additionally at West Byfleet. On Saturday these services will not run.
- On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and Farnborough.
- On Saturday, buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke via Farnborough.
- On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, additional services will run between Farnborough and Basingstoke.
- On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford calling additionally at Wanborough and Ash. On Saturday, these services will be revised and will be diverted via Guildford calling additionally at Walton-on-Thames, Weybridge, West Byfleet, Guildford, Wanborough and Ash.
- Guildford to Farnham services will not run. Passengers should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton services.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale and Aldershot.

Wednesday (New Years Day)

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. Services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Basingstoke. These services will not divide at Eastleigh but will call additionally at Micheldever and Shawford all day.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth Harbour.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at Woking. These services will run hourly.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and Farnborough.
- Additional services will run between Farnborough and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and Ash. These services will run hourly.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale and Aldershot.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will terminate at Aldershot. Passengers for Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to Guildford services.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. Services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Winchester. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth Harbour.
- Additional services will run between Winchester and Southampton Central.
- Buses will run between Woking, Guildford, Basingstoke and Winchester. Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Andover.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking, Guildford, Basingstoke and Andover. Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. These services will not call at Woking but will call additionally at Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will terminate at Weybridge.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be diverted after Addlestone and will terminate at Weybridge.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Guildford via Woking.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Basingstoke via Woking.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Aldershot via Woking.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and Ash. These services will run hourly.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will terminate at Aldershot. Passengers for Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to Guildford services.

CrossCountry and Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for more details.

### Island Line

Closure until May 2025

#### Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade will be closed until May 2025.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

- Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.

#### 2 Brockenhurst to Lymington Pier

The lines between Brockenhurst and Lymington Pier will be closed from Monday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

- Brockenhurst to Lymington Pier services will not run.
- Buses will run between Brockenhurst and Lymington Pier.

### Monday 30 December 2024 to Sunday 5 January 2025

#### 3 Westbury area

The lines in the Westbury area will be closed from Monday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

South Western Railway services via Westbury will be revised. Some services will not run. Other services will terminate at Salisbury or will be diverted via Yeovil Junction to Yeovil Pen Mill.

Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

### Sunday 5 January

#### 4 Leatherhead to Dorking

The lines between Leatherhead and Dorking will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Dorking services will terminate at Leatherhead.
- Buses will run between Leatherhead and Dorking.

#### 5 Queenstown Road area

Some lines in the Queenstown Road area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Services from London Waterloo are subject to minor retiming, with some services departing London Waterloo earlier.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.
