### Monday 6 to Sunday 12 January

#### 1 Westbury area

The lines in the Westbury area will be closed from Monday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

South Western Railway services via Westbury will be revised. Some services will not run. Other services will terminate at Salisbury or will be diverted via Yeovil Junction to Yeovil Pen Mill.

Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

Please note: This work will continue until Thursday 23 January.

### Monday 6 to Wednesday 8 January

#### 2 Haslemere area

Due to maintenance work in the Haslemere area, some late evening services will be cancelled or replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

### Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 January

#### 3 Queenstown Road area

Some lines in the Queenstown Road area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Services from London Waterloo are subject to minor retiming, with some services departing London Waterloo earlier.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all weekend. Please use other nearby stations.

### Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 January

#### 4 4 Basingstoke area

The lines in the Basingstoke area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

CrossCountry and Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for more details.

#### Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An hourly service will depart earlier from London Waterloo and will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central. This service will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will terminate at Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke via Farnborough.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will be diverted via Guildford. These services will call additionally at Walton-on-Thames, Weybridge, Wanborough and Ash.
- Guildford to Farnham services will not run. Passengers should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton services.
- Buses will run between Woking and Aldershot.

#### Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. Services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Winchester. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Winchester and will call additionally at Shawford.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not run.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth all day.
- Additional services will run between Winchester and Southampton Central.
- Buses will run between Woking and Winchester via Guildford and Basingstoke. Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Andover.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Andover via Guildford and Basingstoke.
- Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. These services will not call at Woking but will call additionally at Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will terminate at Weybridge.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and Ash. These services will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will terminate at Hounslow due to other work taking place in the Staines area.
- Buses will run between: Weybridge and Basingstoke via Woking; Weybridge and Guildford via Woking; Weybridge and Aldershot via Woking; Hounslow and Woking via Staines.

### Sunday 12 January

#### 5 Ascot to Guildford

Due to work taking place in the Woking area, services between Ascot and Guildford will be revised all day.

- A revised service will run between Ascot and Aldershot.
- Passengers for Ash, Wanborough and Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to London Waterloo services.

#### 6 Staines area

The lines in the Staines area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Hounslow via Richmond and via Brentford.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Ascot via Staines.
- A revised service will run between Ascot and Reading.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Woking via Staines.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Windsor via Staines.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will run all day and will terminate at Hounslow.

### Island Line

#### Closure until May

#### Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade will be closed until May.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

- Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.
