## Monday 3 to Sunday 9 March

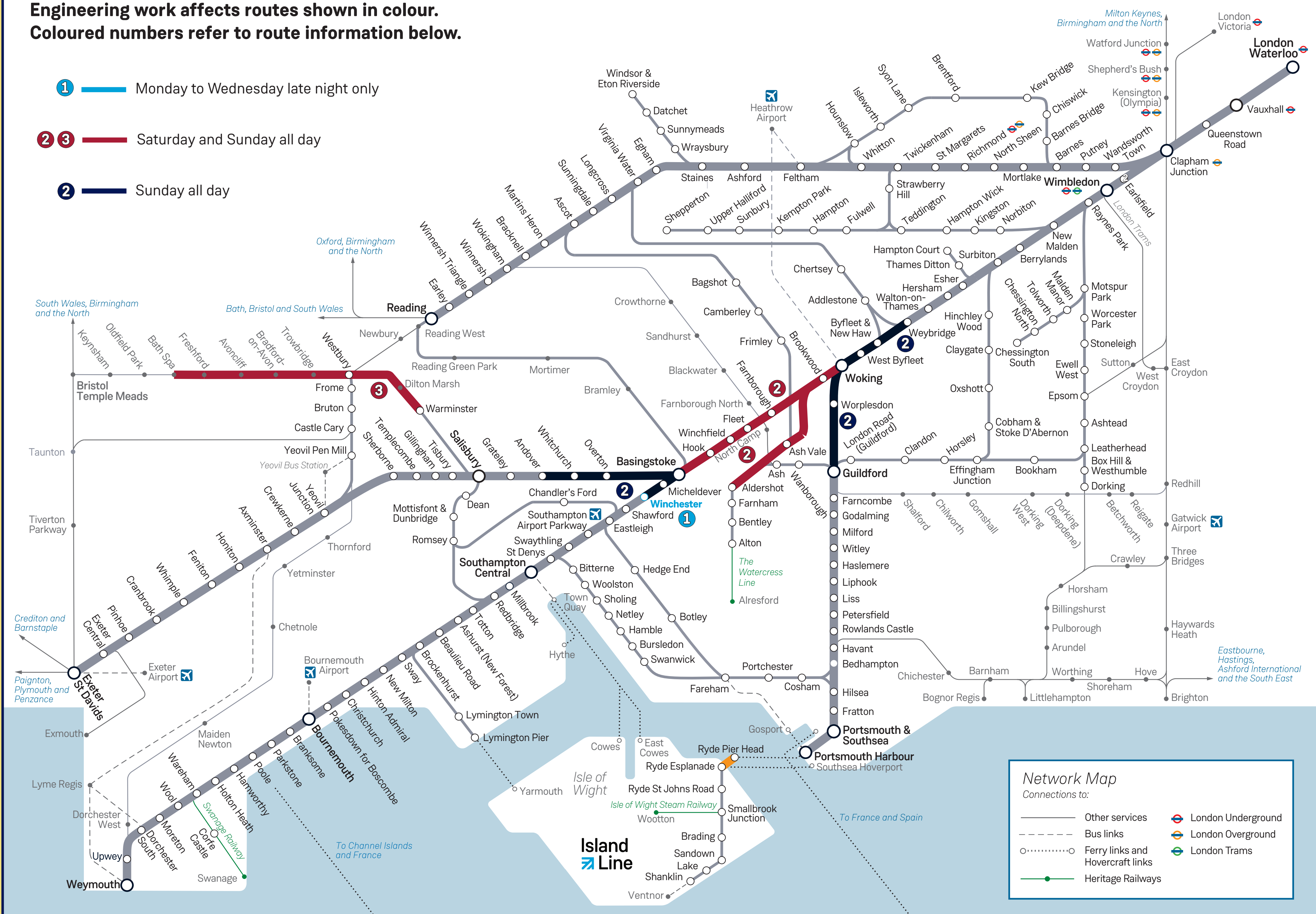
Major engineering work this week will affect journeys in the South Western Railway area. Please check your train times before travelling.

### Monday 3 to Wednesday 5 March

#### 1 Winchester area

Due to maintenance work in the Winchester area, some late evening services will be cancelled or replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

### Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 March

#### 2 2 Basingstoke and Woking areas

The lines in the Basingstoke and Woking areas will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway and CrossCountry services will be affected by this work on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for more details.

#### Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An hourly service will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Airport Parkway and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will terminate at Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo, Clapham Junction and Woking.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke via Farnborough.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will be diverted via Guildford. These services will call additionally at Walton-on-Thames, Weybridge, Wanborough and Ash.
- Guildford to Farnham services will not run. Passengers should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton services.
- A revised service will run between Aldershot and Farnham.
- Buses will run between Woking and Aldershot.

#### Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Winchester. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Winchester and will call additionally at Shawford.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not run.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth all day.
- Additional services will run between Winchester, Southampton Airport Parkway and Southampton Central.
- Buses will run between Woking and Winchester via Guildford and Basingstoke.
- Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Andover.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Andover via Guildford and Basingstoke.
- Passengers from London Waterloo and Clapham Junction should travel on services to Guildford to connect with the bus service.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. These services will not call at Woking but will call additionally at Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will terminate at Weybridge.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be diverted after Addlestone and will terminate at Weybridge.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will run hourly. These services will call additionally at Wanborough and Ash.
- Guildford to Ascot via Aldershot services will be revised and will start from Aldershot.
- Passengers for Aldershot should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton services.
- Buses will run between Weybridge and Basingstoke via Woking
- Weybridge and Guildford via Woking
- Weybridge and Aldershot via Woking

#### 3 Westbury area

The lines between Warmminster and Bath Spa will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

South Western Railway services from London Waterloo to Yeovil via Westbury will terminate at Salisbury.

#### Monday 10 to Friday 14 March

##### Castle Cary area

The lines between Castle Cary and Yeovil will be closed from Monday 10 to Friday 14 March, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

#### Closure until May

##### Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade will be closed until May.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

- Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.
