


Changes to train times

Woking area

The lines in the Woking area will be closed Monday and Tuesday and also Friday to Sunday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An **hourly** service will depart **earlier** from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham. An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading on Monday and Tuesday only. On Friday and Saturday they will start from Basingstoke.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at Woking. These services will call additionally at West Byfleet.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and Farnborough.
- Additional services will run between Farnborough and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and
- Guildford to Farnham services will not run. Passengers should travel on the revised London Waterloo to Alton
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale and Aldershot.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. Services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Basingstoke. These services will **not** divide at **Eastleigh** but will call additionally at Micheldever and Shawford all day.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth Harbour.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingstoke.
- Reading to Salisbury services will start from Basingstoke.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke (non-stop).
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will terminate at Woking. These services will run hourly.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood and Farnborough.
- Additional services will run between Farnborough and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Guildford and will call additionally at Wanborough and Ash. These services will run hourly.
- Buses will run between Woking, Brookwood, Ash Vale and Aldershot.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will terminate at Aldershot. Passengers for Guildford should change at Aldershot and travel on the revised Alton to Guildford
