
Changes to train times Monday 30 December 2024 until Sunday 5 January 2025

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An hourly service will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford. Havant and Fareham. An hourly service will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- On Saturday only, London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will terminate at Guildford
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Basingsto
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking
